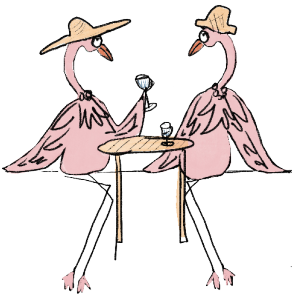

Every morning, Baha Mar hosts a Flamingo Parade near Tingung on the Sand.

The Caribbean flamingo (*Phoenicopterus ruber*) is the national bird of The Bahamas.

The largest population in The Bahamas is found on Great Inagua Island, home to over 50,000 flamingos, primarily in the Inagua National Park.

Their striking pink color comes from their diet which includes brine shrimp and algae rich in carotenoids.

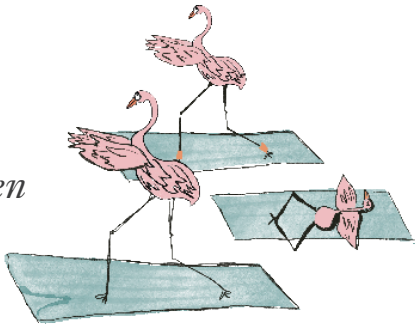
